They also need efficient, ball-proof surround fencing with access in the most convenient places. They need well finished, durable posts and nets. Increasingly often they need floodlighting, as the virtually all-weather performance of modern surfaces encourages people to play after dark in autumn, winter and spring. And they may well need a range of other accessories such as umpires' chairs, coaching aids and maintenance equipment.

FENCING, FLOODLIGHTS AND ACCESSORIES

SURROUND FENCING

We offer fencing in a range of different types, styles and colours. For example, posts may be angle iron or tubular sections. The most common infill is green plastic-coated chainlink, with gates inset where required. Standard height is 2.75m (9ft), but greater height can be provided on sides adjacent to roads or properties, or lower fences at one side or both to create a relaxed setting for viewing. We also supply rebound board systems for multi-sport use.



FLOODLIGHTING SYSTEMS

By extending playing time into hours of darkness, floodlights can make an enormous contribution to the enjoyment value of a tennis court to a club or private owner, and can increase the return on the original court investment from a commercially run facility.

We offer a comprehensive selection of different floodlighting systems to suit the technical needs and budgets of different types of user. They range from conventional high-level lighting using four or six columns to multi-column low-level systems. Common to most modern floodlighting systems is their ability to provide high levels of consistent light on the court with minimal spillage in other directions, so reducing the likelihood of problems with planning authorities or neighbours.



LANDSCAPING

As part of a complete court project Charles Lawrence Surfaces Ltd is pleased to undertake landscaping of the surrounding area. The building of paths, walls, steps or terraces, the formation of earth banks or slopes and the planting of grass or appropriate shrubs or trees can contribute positively to the final appearance of a court facility. New construction projects may require major initial earthworks, especially on sloping sites, and the disposal of surplus soil and reinstatement of damaged ground must always be considered. We pride ourselves on leaving sites in a state that will, after due time for recovery, look attractive for many years to come and enhance the enjoyment of our tennis playing customers.

ACCESSORIES

Posts, nets and fittings: a variety of designs for private, club or tournament play.
