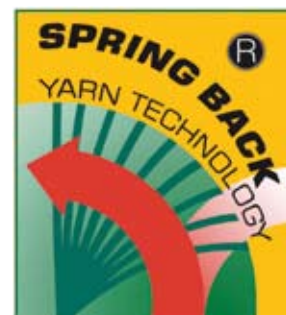

The **LigaTurf®** range of surfaces offers the ultimate synthetic turf football surface. Within the range of different pile heights and base specifications there are systems which meet the FIFA 2 Star performance standard, in fact **LigaTurf®** has more FIFA 2 Star installations today than any other system currently available.

Furthermore, due to the ACS system **LigaTurf®** has more re-tested pitches meeting FIFA 2 Star than any other system, confirming that **LigaTurf®** will maintain its playing characteristics for longer. The strong soft fibres will provide a surface of the highest quality capable of withstanding intensive use.

The unique 'Spring Back' fibre technology provides more upright fibres which are softer on contact.



MAINTENANCE AND RENEWAL

Routine Maintenance: Brush pitch regularly to redistribute infill and prevent compaction. Remove debris and inspect surface to monitor infill levels.

Professional Maintenance: Apply moss / weed killer as necessary. Use ACS machine to decompact infill. Typically after 5 - 7 years rejuvenate the pitch to restore playing characteristics. After typically 10 - 12 years on full size pitches renew the carpet (less on 5-a-side pitches, depending on usage).
