The **LigaTurf®** unique monofilament fibres ensures both durability and player friendly characteristics making it an excellent surface for rugby. ACS (Anti Compaction System) is recommended for rugby use to ensure the performance standards are met. The surface will also accommodate football use.

THE CHOICE OF CARPET

The **LigaTurf®** range of surfaces offers the ultimate synthetic turf rugby surface. The anti-compaction system incorporates a porous rubber shockpad to ensure the performance standards are met year on year. The strong soft fibres will provide a surface of the highest quality capable of withstanding intensive use. The unique 'Spring Back' fibre technology provides more upright fibres which are softer on contact. Our **LigaTurf®** ACS system meets the requirements of the IRB Regulation 22.

MAINTENANCE AND RENEWAL

Routine Maintenance: Brush pitch regularly to redistribute infill and prevent compaction. Remove debris and inspect surface to monitor infill levels.

Professional Maintenance: Apply moss / weed killer as necessary. Use ACS machine to decompact infill. Typically after 5 - 7 years rejuvenate the pitch to restore playing characteristics. After typically 10 - 12 years on full size pitches renew the carpet.
